AutoCAD and the AutoCAD Architecture Autodesk AutoCAD, and its subsequent upgrade software AutoCAD LT, are a complex piece of software, with different purpose, functions, and user interfaces. History Autodesk AutoCAD was introduced at the 1983 Association for Computing Machinery (ACM) Symposium on User Interface Software and Technology (UIST) held in Chicago in May 1983. (UIST was later renamed the SIGCHI conference, as the group changed name to the Association for Computing Machinery.) The first release of AutoCAD for DOS was also released at the UIST 1983 conference. AutoCAD for DOS was an early release, having been written in early 1982 before the programming team had switched from their earlier C.V.CAD software to X-Windows. AutoCAD was originally written in C. It is now written in C++. The name AutoCAD was chosen in consultation with the consulting firm of Paces Consulting, then based in Concord, California, in November 1981. One of the members of the consulting team, Dr. Robert Orr, wanted to use the initials "AoC" for AutoCAD (Acronym of Consulting). The name AutoCAD was chosen over "Acrea" and "Acra". "Auto" was chosen from the Latin word for self-powered. The logo designed for AutoCAD in 1981 was based on a calligraphic

Autodesk Alias for AutoCAD is a cloud service, now owned by Autodesk, Inc. It supports 2D, 3D and parametric drawing in DWG, DXF and SVG. DBX is a format for storing a database, including tables and data. It can be used to store 3D CAD information, and is included as part of AutoCAD. In addition to the standard menu bars, AutoCAD offers a number of add-ons available for download. These add-ons can be used to automate processes, create features, export and annotate drawings. Add-ons can be added by buying from the AutoCAD User and Developer Center. Some add-ons are offered at no cost, while others require a license. Using stored procedures, AutoCAD can import CAD objects into DWG. These stored procedures can also automate database operations such as creating drawings from a number of databases. AutoCAD can be used to process Excel, Word, and PDF documents. AutoCAD's right-click context menu includes the ability to "fold", "unfold", "collapse", "expand" or "flip" a block (group) of drawing elements on a layout view, which makes the layout more readable. The Block Command has a similar set of functions. For example, a block of a certain color can be made to float on a plane and become the background for the block that follows. The program can create AutoCAD projects that contain certain parameters, which in turn, can be passed to multiple drawings. These projects can contain schedules for drawings, locations, fonts, scales, families, layouts and a number of other parameters. AutoCAD has a native version for Microsoft Windows.

Portable versions of the Windows-based AutoCAD are also available for: Apple Mac OS X (version 10.4 and later), Linux and Sun Solaris, and for iOS. AutoCAD for iOS is a native version designed for the iPhone, iPad, and iPod touch. The iOS version is available from the App Store. There are versions for Android, and both native and cross-platform versions for the BlackBerry. On October 23, 2011, Autodesk launched AutoCAD Cloud, a service which offers cloud-based access to CAD data files and 3D models for free. iOS version The AutoCAD app for iOS was launched on October 23, 2011.
